



THE VESPA CLUB BOLOGNA ARRANGE

70° ANNIVERSARY OF THE 1° INTERNATIONAL VESPA

MEETING OF VESPA CLUB D'ITALIA

Bologna, 23/24 Maggio 2020

Art. 1 – GENERAL EVENT NOTES.

The Vespa Club Bologna, based in Bologna in Via Della Battaglia 9, CF 91356030378, in collaboration with the Vespa Club of Italy, arrange the event called "**70th Anniversary of the 1st International Vespa Meeting of Vespa Club D'Italia**", to be held in Bologna from 23 to 24 May 2020. The event it's in the Vespa Club d'Italia events calendar. Registration is open only to members of the Vespa Club of Italy, with the exception of the members of the Honor Committee, set up by the Organization. Membership to a Vespa Club affiliated to the Vespa World Club is required for people from abroad.

Adhesions will be accepted with chronological criteria of receipt of duly completed membership applications, after checking the requirements according to enrollment rules. The Vespa Club Bologna reserves itself to modify the program of this event, giving immediate notice to the registered people.

Art. 2 – ENROLLMENT LIMITATIONS.

The total number of participants is fixed to 200 people max.

The Vespa models admitted will be only of the "Faro Basso" type and may be of national construction or by foreign licensees (Allstate, Douglas, Hoffman, Motovespa and ACMA). The vehicles must also belong to the production period between 1946 and 1957.

The vehicles must be as specified by the House: any technical elaboration or modification will not be allowed, except those deriving from regulatory adjustments to the Traffic laws.

In order to make the Parade a moment of respectful decoration, it is forbidden to participate with exhaust system with ineffective silencer.

Art. 3 – REFISTRATIONS FEE.

Registration fee is fixed at:

a) for the driver: € 230.00

b) for the passenger (only one): € 150,00

The enrollment tax of the driver covers:

- Event poster
- Invitation for the Congress:

- Town centre guided tour

The enrollment tax of the passengers covers:

- Invitation for the Congress:
«The Vespismo flag»
- Town centre guided tour
- Panoramic Tour of the City by open Bus
- Luncheon (Sunday 24/05)

The Vespa Club Bologna can at any time modify and integrate the program, replace, delete or add gadgets or activities to the above list, giving prompt communication to the members.

According to the Tour provider policy, the bus tour will not take place if the weather will be bad: there won't be refunds in this case.



Art. 4 – METHOD OF REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT OF THE FEE.

A) Registrations are presented on the specific form prepared by the organization and sent exclusively by e-mail to the address internazionale1950-2020@vespaclubbologna.it

B) For economical and organizational reasons, the payment of the fee must be made exclusively through the bank circuit: a copy of the accounting of the payment must be sent to the email address referred to in the previous point together with the registration form. No other payment methods will be accepted.

C) The registration fee is not refundable, except for any rejection by the organization as provided for in Article 2 above or if the enrollment limit is exceeded.

D) It is not possible to register on the day of the event.

The Radunist who has submitted an application for registration will receive a confirmation communication or any rejection of his application.

A printed copy of the registration confirmation communication must be presented when registering for the event and will be the only valid receipt proving the registration.

Incomplete registrations will not be accepted.

Art. 5 – THE PARADE AND DISTINCTIVE EMBLEMS ON VEHICLES.

To celebrate the dawn of the Movement and inspired by the First International Meeting of the Vespa Club of Italy which was held in Bologna on 20 and 21 May 1950, on the days covered by the event the participating Vespas will not be harnessed with any Club item with exception for the Vespa Clubs existing in the reference period: the organization will provide an identification item to be mandatory affixed in the front of Vespas by the participants.

Those who agree to participate in the event have the right but also the duty to take part to the Parade.

During the Parade, serious commitment by the driver is required, who must pay attention and maintain the correct and orderly pace of travel imposed by the leader; in order to maintain a proper uniformity during its development, it will always travel in a row for three.

At the Parade, your turn will be assigned by the organization.

The Parade will be opened by the leader appointed by the Vespa Club Bologna, who will travel to the top of the parade supporting the Vespa Club of Italy banner reproduced for the occasion on the basis of the hystorical testimonies.

Art. 6 – GALA LUNCHEON.

The Gala Luncheon on Sunday 24 May 2020 requires mandatory vintage clothing.

Art. 7 – LOGISTIC AND ACCOMODATION.

Each participant and accompanying person must independently provide for their own hotel accommodation; reservations can be made at the facilities suggested by the Vespa Club Bologna or by their own criteria.

Art. 8 - RESPONSIBILITIES.

Only original vehicles, insured and in compliance with the ministerial review, can be admitted to this event. The Vespa Club Bologna declines all responsibility towards the participants, who fully assume responsibility and declare the compliance of their vehicle with the Traffic laws. The Vespa Club Bologna is not responsible for any claims by the participants and third parties as a consequence of any act or omission committed by the participant.

The organization declines all responsibility towards drivers, passengers or third parties for personal injury, property damage and economic damage in general both before and during and after the event. The traffic and road safety regulations are valid for all parts and duration of the event.

By submitting the application for registration, the participant declares to accept the general rules and guidelines of this event, including this particular regulation, exempting the Vespa Club Bologna, the Vespa Club of Italy when registering for the event , as well as the sponsoring bodies and collaborators, from any liability for damage to things or people. By way of example, but not limited to, the driver and any passenger must wear the approved protective helmet, protective clothing compliant with the law, respect the speed limits, refrain from driving after drinking alcohol or if you are not in perfect psychophysical conditions.

Art. 9 – ACCEPTANCE OF REGULATIONS.

With the submission of the application for registration, the participant declares to accept the general and particular rules prepared and published by the organization, in addition to the event guidelines; also accepts for the use of their data for the purpose of carrying out the event.



Art. 10 - SURVEILLANCE SERVICE.

Participants are warned that video surveillance systems may be present in the places where the event will take place. In particular, in Piazza VIII of August, where the vehicles will be concentrated and parked during the gala dinner, there will be a security service in charge of vehicle surveillance.

Art. 11 – IMAGE RIGHTS.

Upon registration, the participant authorizes the Vespa Club Bologna to disclose photographic images or videos taken during the event in which the participant is portrayed / filmed, the accompanying persons even if they are minors against him.

Art. 12 – PRIVACY.

The participant, having read the privacy policy and acquired the information provided by the data controller pursuant to art.13 and 14 of the European Regulation 679/2016 (GDPR), gives his consent to the processing of the necessary personal and sensitive data for the holding of the event.

Art. 13 – ROADSIDE ASSISTANCE.

During the whole event and following the various movements, a service van is provided for the recovery of damaged vehicles, which will be returned to the owners in Piazza dell'VIII August Bologna.

Art. 14 - UNLAWFUL BEHAVIORS AND EXCLUSION.

- a) the participant that endangers the safety of others, the reputation of the event or who damages vehicles or infrastructure will be reported to the competent Authorities and required to pay compensation for the damage caused; it can be excluded from the event without compensation or refund of the fee by the Vespa Club Bologna.
- b) the participant who has sent incorrect data for his registration will be automatically excluded from the event, without the right to any refund.

Against the decisions of the organization, a complaint may be lodged pursuant to art. 15 of this regulation.

Art. 15 - CLAIMS.

Any type of complaint must be promptly communicated to the Organizing Committee within 24 hours and sent in writing to the Vespa Club Bologna by e-mail at the address internazionale1950-2020@vespaclubbologna.it, with the caution of 100,00 (one hundred/00) euro. Generic and counter-unknown complaints will not be considered.

The Vespa Club Bologna will examine the complaint within 48 hours and will respond with an irrevocable provision. In case of acceptance, the deposit will be returned, in case of rejection the same will be retained by the organization.
